**The Liquor Licensing Act, 2011**  
(Act No. 20 of 2011)

**The Liquor Licensing (Permitted Hours)  
Regulations, 2011**

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in section *fifty-three* of the Liquor Licensing Act, the following Regulations are hereby made:

1. These Regulations may be cited as Liquor Licensing (Permitted Hours) Regulations, 2011. Title
2. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires— Interpretation  
“Area” means the area under the jurisdiction of a local authority; and  
“local authority” means a city council, municipal council or district council established under the Local Government Act. Cap.281
3. These Regulations apply to the area of every local authority. Application
4. The permitted hours for the sale of intoxicating liquor shall be as prescribed in the Schedule. Permitted hours
